### WHERE TO GO ON ARRIVAL

Buses run regularly from the train station and the city centre, taking ~20 minutes to arrive on campus. Alternatively, a taxi will take ~10 minutes at a cost of ~£10. Upon arrival, please make your way to Barker House Farm (building 65 on the campus map) for registration between 14:00 and 17:00 on July 9<sup>th</sup>. At registration, you will receive your badge and the information on how to reach the lecture theatres and computer lab.

### Lecture Theatre and Computer Lab

Lectures for the main school will be held in the Biology Lecture Theatre (room 43a on the campus map). The practical sessions will be held in the Ash House computer labs (rooms 15 on the campus map). A full timetable giving details of the location of advanced course lectures and other details will be provided in your registration pack.

### Registration

Registration will take place between **14:00 and 17:00** on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> July in Barker House Farm (building 65 on the campus map). Here you will receive a welcome pack which will include the lecture notes for the course and login details for the practical session. If you will not arrive by 17:00, you can collect keys for your accommodation until 11:00 from the CETAD building (building number 13 on the campus map). The first lecture will start at **09:00 am** on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> July in the Biology Lecture Theatre.

### **Poster Session**

The poster session will take place on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July in the Foyer of the Faraday building (building 27 on the campus map). If you are presenting a poster it is advised that you arrive 15 minutes early in order to hang your poster.

Meals will be provided, starting with a welcome dinner in Barker House Farm on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> July. All breakfasts, lunches and dinners will also be provided at the same location with the exception of Friday July 14<sup>th</sup> and Saturday July 15<sup>th</sup> (details of which will be given during the school). Note that on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> July you have the day to explore the city of Lancaster and the surrounding area.
